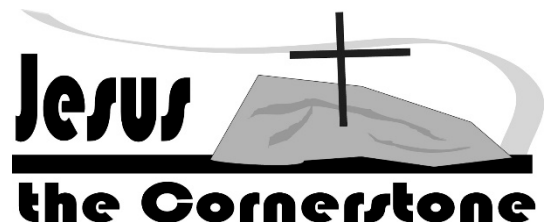
### *In Loving Remembrance*

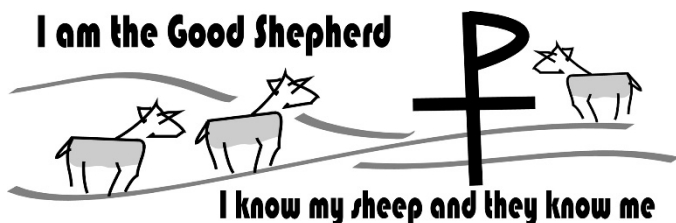

## **Anointing of the Sick/Hospital Visits**

The confidentiality laws that affect the ministry of the Church have changed. You are asked on an admission form what religion you are. Naturally responding "Roman Catholic" you expect that a Catholic Chaplain will come by to see you. This is particularly important if you are going to be there over a weekend when Eucharistic Ministers can bring you Holy Communion. Be prepared to let them know that you would like to pray with them and receive Holy Communion unless you need confession.

The Admissions Office will no longer provide a list for local clergy according to the new Hippa laws, other than a generic list of Roman Catholic patients in the entire hospital. This is helpful for the chaplains who visit with each Catholic patient. If you want to see a priest during a hospital stay at Orange Regional Medical Center, a Chaplain is available. If you would like one of Sacred Heart's priests to visit the hospital, you need to call the parish office and give the name, room number, bed and phone number of the person you would like us to visit. If you would like to receive the Sacrament of the Sick, we would be happy to anoint you.

## **Closed Captioned Mass for Hearing Impaired**

Are you deaf or hard of hearing? If so, we can't imagine not hearing the message of God all for the lack of hearing. That is why we offer captioning services at our Saturday, 5:30 pm Mass. The baptismal side section has been designated as the area for this service. As the Mass is conducted the spoken word is displayed on a marquee placed in front of the pulpit. We invite you and your friends to come share the Word of God each week at our technologically advanced Mass.

## **Sacrament of Marriage**

We invite and encourage couples who are planning marriage to speak with one of the priests or deacons. It is the policy of Sacred Heart Parish that the couples begin marriage preparation at least six months prior to the planned date. Fr. Byrnes must approve any departures from the policy. This is in order to allow time for the necessary paperwork, meetings with the priest or deacon as well as for the Pre-Cana program. The date at the Church is the first priority. Sometimes parishioners are surprised to find that the date and time they want is not available.
